As one of the INTER-UNIVERSITY EXCHANGE PROJECTS by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Hiroshima University launched the "International Collaborative Human Resources Development Program in Asia to Foster Inclusive Minds" program in 2021, which consists of COIL-type education (online), summer school (in Hiroshima), short-term study abroad (in Asia), and semester study abroad (in Asia).

The goal of this program is to provide a higher quality educational collaboration through mutual learning and exchange between students of Hiroshima University and students of the partner universities in Asia. 18 students from five Asian universities and six students from Hiroshima University will gather at Hiroshima University to learn how to develop human resources who can recognize communication barriers arising from differences in views on peace, religion, gender/minority, etc.
